#### Abstract

According to the by-laws, E. H. Granger and Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Hall each contributed \$100 to create the Granger-Hall Electric Company in 1912. They sold electricity to residential and business customers throughout Ontario and Upland from 1912-1917, according to their Accounts Payable ledger. Customers included the Cities of Ontario and Upland, Chaffey College, local schools and businesses.

The company also bid successfully on at least one construction contract for the City of Ontario in 1915 to provide "an ornamental lighting system in West A street (Holt Blvd.) in the block between Laurel and Palm avenues", according to an article in the Daily Report on Dec. 21, 1915.

It is not known why the company ledgers do not continue after 1917. The collection consists of four ledgers from 1912-1917 containing accounts payable, the by-laws of the company, minutes, and a record of checks drawn.
