

Trunk or Treat FAQ

Is there a fee to attend?

Trunk or Treat has a FREE admission and is open to all ages.

What time does the Trunk or Treat start?

Admission gates open at 4:15 PM, and the event officially begins at 4:30 PM

Are pets allowed?

Pets are allowed as long as they are secured on a leash and any messes must be cleaned up.

Are Halloween costumes allowed?

Yes, participants are welcome to wear their Halloween costumes. Interested participants can choose to compete in the Costume Contest. Age divisions include 0-5, 6-11, 12-17, adults (18+), and family. Participants will check in at the stage on the day of the event. All costumes MUST be family-friendly and appropriate for all ages.

Where can participants park?

Free parking will be available at the Ontario Police Department (2500 S. Archibald Ave.) and participants will be shuttled over to the Westwind Park. Shuttling will begin at 4 PM.

Participants who require ADA assistance can parking inside of the Westwind Park lot. Plaque is required and must be shown to the parking attendants on the day of the event.

What activities will be available at Trunk or Treat?

Participants can enjoy trick or treating by visiting each trunk entry along the treat trail. Inflatable Games, a Haunted Maze, Food Vendors and a live concert by Phat Cat Swinger will also be available. It is encouraged to bring lawn chairs and blankets to sit back and enjoy the event.

Will food and refreshments be available?

Yes, food and refreshments will be available for purchase from the variety of food vendors in attendance.

What time is the Drone Show, and where is the best viewing location? The drone show will begin at 8 PM and can best be viewed in the pre-marked "Viewing Area" that is located in front of the stage.
Alcohol is strictly forbidden at this event.
